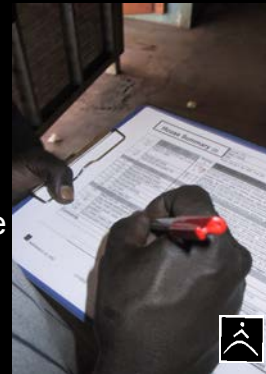


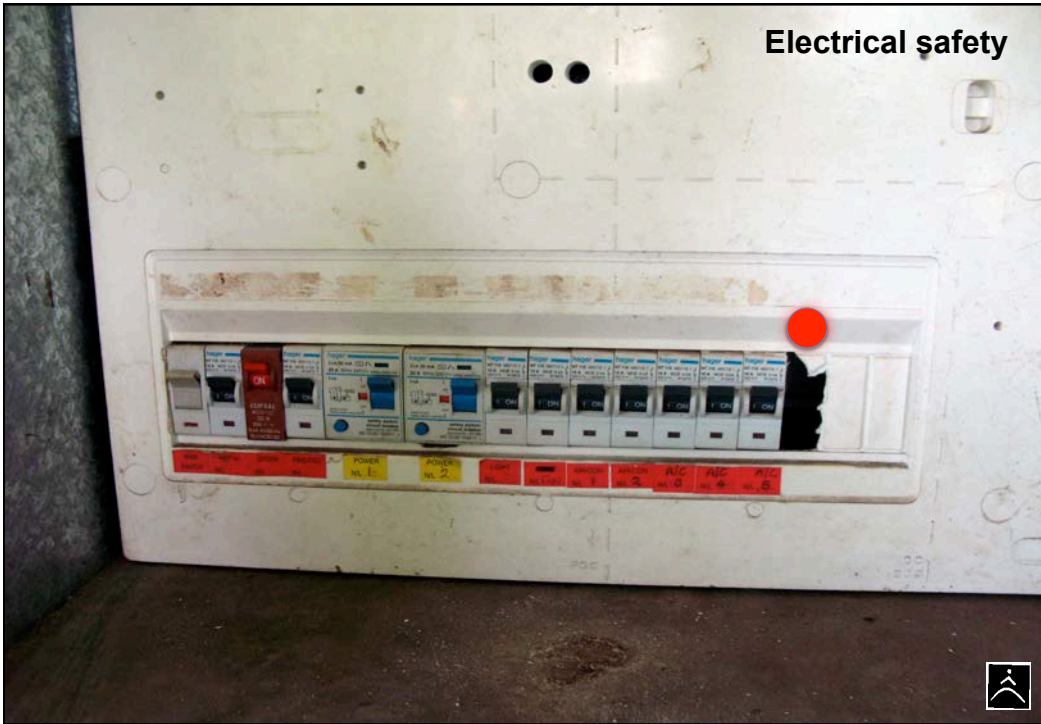
2 houses completed by the NPARIH upgrading in 2009 and were
